







We are excited to present the new format for the FIP EURO PADEL CUP. This proposal is the result of careful consideration and aims to address key goals for FIP.

### **Maximize participation:**

We want to include as many National Teams as possible.

### **Efficient logistics:**

The new event format will enable the Teams to organize a maximum of 2 trips.

### **Accessibility:**

More accessible conditions for countries willing to host the event.

### **Competitive balance:**

The structure shall reward players' skills and ensure fair competition.

### **Opportunities for all:**

Every participating Team shall have a realistic chance to qualify.

# A NEW FORMULA

# To achieve these objectives, competitions are divided into 3 parts:

**Phase 1**: 24 European Teams. This is the qualifying phase open to all National Teams not participating in the Phase 2 and Final 8. Teams will be grouped based on the number of entries, and the format will be designed to ensure equal, fair and exciting competition.

**Phase 2**: This stage will include the 12 Teams ranked 5th to 16th plus 4 Teams from Phase 1. They will be divided into 4 groups of 4, with the best Team from each group advancing to FINAL 8.

**FINAL 8**: This is the top-tier competition, featuring the 4 highest-ranked teams with direct qualification, plus 4 teams advancing from Phase 2.


